






# Transforming Futures

With generous support from the community, the Foothill-De Anza Foundation helps our colleges create pathways for students to succeed. This support can be life changing for many students. A peanut butter sandwich, bottle of shampoo or blanket might seem inconsequential, but to a student who is struggling day to day to meet basic needs, these necessities offer care and encouragement. More substantial support such as book vouchers, scholarships and paid internships provide the extra financial relief that allows cash-strapped students to remain in college. Community support also underwrites unique extracurricular experiences that give students valuable global perspective and expand their view of how they fit into their communities and the world. Our students have opportunities to visit the state capital and our nation's capital, and recently became the first community college students to participate in an archeological dig in Kenya. Your support enables us to do this important work.



## De Anza College EOPS Scholars Pilot Program

The EOPS Scholars pilot program is a new initiative that provides additional support to a targeted group of 20 students during their second year with Extended Opportunity Programs & Services (EOPS). EOPS annually assists nearly 900 academically disadvantaged and low-income students with academic and financial support. Building upon the EOPS support system, De Anza's EOPS Scholars program provides students with extra counseling, full textbook assistance and food vouchers as well as instructional materials such as calculators and laptop computers. The objective is to close the student achievement gap within the EOPS program while identifying which additional areas of support increase student success.



### **Scholarships**

About one in five students require financial aid to attend college and even more can barely afford to live in this area. Scholarships provide much needed support and perhaps more importantly, the motivation and self-confidence it takes for students to persevere in higher education. The Foundation awarded more than \$475,000 in scholarships last year to hundreds of students at Foothill and De Anza colleges.

## Foothill College Science Learning Institute Internships

Since 2011, the Science Learning Institute (SLI) has been creating a new generation of scientists, engineers, teachers and technicians. A major challenge for many students, especially those who are financially disadvantaged, is the need to work many hours to support themselves and/or their families while attending college. The demanding academic load of a STEM major only adds to their challenge. Through a generous bequest, for the past two years a STEM Intern Scholarship has provided 31 students each with \$2,000 awards, paving the way for them to take part in a six-week summer internship program with professional mentoring and hands-on experience at Bay Area research institutions and technology companies.

# De Anza College Design & Manufacturing Technologies

De Anza's Design and Manufacturing Technologies Department (DMT) offers some of the nation's leading technical training programs and serves more than 1,500 students annually. Because of its program quality, De Anza was chosen as a Haas Technical Education Center (HTEC) to offer skilled training to prepare students for some of the 3.5 million-plus manufacturing jobs anticipated over the next decade. Recently the Gene Haas Foundation awarded \$1 million to expand DMT's classroom and labs. The renovation will be completed by the end of 2017, in time for winter quarter. Additionally, the Haas Foundation is committed to providing scholarships to the region's students and teachers for training at De Anza.

### **Basic Needs**

Food insecurity and homelessness are widespread among college students, including many at Foothill College. Students who don't have a permanent home may be "couch-surfing" or even living in their cars. With hopes of a brighter future, they remain determined and continue with their education. Yet when faced with homelessness and hunger, the success of even the most steadfast student is put at risk.



Thanks to our partners, Second Harvest Food Bank and the Community Services Agency of Mountain View, Los Altos & Los Altos Hills, Foothill College is fortunate to have been able to open and maintain a Food Pantry. In addition, a generous anonymous donor has ensured that this highly vulnerable student population will receive additional help with basic necessities. Foothill counselors can draw on this gift to provide students with gift cards, blankets and toiletry items such as toothbrushes, toothpaste, shampoo and soap. This kind of support alleviates stress and helps students stay on track.
